Performance Guidelines

This is a women-only event, the aim of the which is to get together to share our love of barbershop harmony with our sisters in Scotland. This is an opportunity for small groups to perform for each other with the focus firmly on fun.

- Each chorus should have no fewer than 12 and no more than 25 singers.
- Each chorus must be directed by someone who is not normally a frontline director.
- Female frontline directors are free to sing in a chorus.
- Each singer must only sing with one group (exceptions may be made in the case of tenors!)
- Performers will have no more than 10 minutes on stage.
- There must be one barbershop song and any other material of your choice to fill the remaining time.
- There will be risers
- The format will be informal. Performers will sit in the audience until it is their turn to perform when they will just get up on the risers to sing. There will be no requirement to line up and no traffic pattern.
- The order of appearance will be decided as we go along.
- Costume guidelines - please wear something!
- Make up guidelines - please look bonnie!
